

**Activity Name:**

Visit at the pharmacy

**Educational area of reference:**

Communication, orienteering in the street, use of money, use of stores

**Goals / Objectives:**

- Buying your medicines at the pharmacy at your own
- Knowing where you can find the pharmacy
- Thinking to prepare your notes what you want to buy at the pharmacy
- Paying the bill of the stuff you buy

**Number of participants:**

1- 3 participants

**Time needed:**

3 hours

**Description:**

The participants will meet at the local of the association. Neither the participants can bring a medical prescription, or they make a list at home or with the aid of the educator of articles from pharmacy they need at home for daily issues. The educator shows some articles that you buy in the pharmacy and ask if they know where you can find, after the educator explains to the participants what belongs to the "house pharmacy" / "first-aid-kit".

The participants can also open the first aid kit in the association to see, which articles are inside and discuss the use of them. The educator must also introduce the difference between the things that we can ask directly at the pharmacy and the things (medicine) that need a prescription of the doctor. He can also explain that some things you can find also in a supermarket and others no and giving some examples.



After that the participants can go together to the pharmacy to see what kind of articles exist there. At the pharmacy the participants are going to wait for their turn, maybe depending on the pharmacy, the participants need to take a ticket with a number. Either the participants can ask the pharmacist for specific articles or give him the list of articles they need. The participants will pay the bill and put the bought articles in a bag. The participants are going to say thank you for this service and taking the bill with them at home. The participants are going back to the local of the association.
